BCC REGULAR MEMBERSHIP 21 YEARS OLD

BCC Regular Membership for persons 21 years of age:

CLASSIC SF - GOLDEN GATE BIKE RIDE



If you haven't ridden since our last ride in June, get those bike tires filled up with air and start riding to get those legs in shape. If you missed the last ride, you won't want to miss this next one on Saturday, October 15. It will be our tourist ride which will be shorter (30-35 miles) than the previous ones (which were 40-45 miles), but a bit more challenging. In spite of that, it will be scenic and the rewards will be worth it.

The ride will start at the host's restaurant (Gerald's own "Piperade") located on Battery and Green Street, a couple of blocks from lower Broadway Street. The ride will start at 8AM SHARP! The ride will continue on Embarcadero Road toward Fisherman's Wharf and onto the Golden Gate Bridge. We will go across the bridge towards Sausalito and eventually return across the bridge and continue onto the Legion of Honor (northwest of SF) and down the hill around the Cliff House to Golden Gate Park.

Several routes are being looked at from that location that will include the Twin Peaks Hill and down toward the Haight and proceeding toward downtown and eventually hitting the AT&T Ballpark which will be the last mile before returning to the restaurant for lunch.

As usual, there will be two routes which will overlap at various points along the way.

Talk to anyone that has gone on one of our rides and they've all had a great experience. Please let me know if you are interested in riding. I am also looking for a sag wagon crew as they provide the riders with both moral support and equipment such as food, drinks, rest and flat tire changing tools.
