


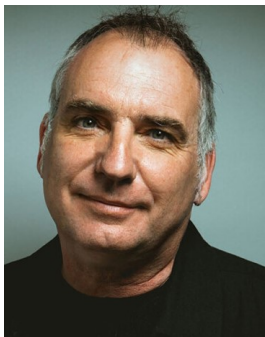

Fernando Bernues (San Sebastian, 1961) is a founding member of Tanttaka Teatroa and Tentazioa Produksioak and has developed a recognized career in theatre, cinema and television. Worthy of mention among the works he has directed for theatre are *El florido pensil*, *Novecento: El pianista del Océano* and *Sueños de una noche de verano* (A Midsummer Night's Dream). For cinema he has co-directed with Mireia Gabilondo the feature films *Kutsidazu bidea*, *Ixabel* (Show Me the Way, *Ixabel*, 2005), presented in San Sebastian's New Directors section and *Mugaldekoak* (2009), screened in Zinemira. *Soinujolearen semea* (The Accordionist's Son) was part of the Official Selection at the Huelva Festival.
